This ruling was expected from this conservative court and came on the same day that Justice Kennedy, the court's swing vote, announced his retirement. There are legislators who will fight for working families and an economy that works for all individuals, and not just the top 1%. We must see they get elected to turn this tide into a Blue Wave.
